

VERSES OF BLESSING

- Gen 12:2 And I will make of you • a great nation, and I will **ble**ss you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing.
- Gen 12:3 • I will bless those who **ble**ss you, and him who dishonours you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”
- Gen 17:16 • I will bless • her, and moreover, I will give • you a son by her. • I will **ble**ss her, and she shall become nations; kings of peoples shall come from her.”
- Gen 26:3 Sojourn in • • this land, and I will be with you and will **ble**ss you, for to you and to your offspring I will give • all • these • lands, and I will establish • the oath that I swore to Abraham your father.
- Gen 26:24 And the Lord appeared to him • the • same night and said, “I am the God of Abraham your father. Fear not, for I am with you and will **ble**ss you and multiply • your offspring for my servant Abraham’s sake.”
- Gen 27:4 and prepare for me delicious food, such as I love, and bring it to me so that I may eat, that my soul may **ble**ss you before I die.”

- 2 Sam 18:28 Then Ahimaaz cried out • • to the king, “All is well.” And he bowed before the king with his face to the earth and said, “**Blessed** be the Lord your God, who has delivered up • the men who raised • their hand against my lord the king.”
- 2 Sam 22:47 “The Lord lives, and **blessed** be my rock, and exalted be my God, the rock of my salvation,
